The entire studio is hard at work and bursting with excitement as our show date draws near. The students, staff and coaches have all been focusing and preparing for what will be an amazing performance! We would like to thank all our families, students, volunteers and studio staff in advance for their support and enthusiasm as this proves to be not only an unforgettable but meaningful performance! Please take a moment to review key dates, times and important information and guidelines for the showcase. **ALL STUDENTS are expected to participate** so to help the coaches organize the acts ***please complete the student information form and return to the front desk ASAP if you have not already done so!***

DRESS REHEARSAL SCHEDULE Saturday 10/28: NO MARTIAL ARTS CLASSES THIS DAY!

STUDENTS MUST ATTEND REHEARSAL AT FOOTHILL COLLEGE'S SMITHWICK THEATRE (12345 El Monte Rd, Los Altos Hills)

Please be on time and plan on staying for 45-90 minutes (White & Yellow belts will be on the shorter side while BBC members & advanced belts will likely stay longer). We thank you in advance for your patience as we will be marking the show and finalizing timing for each act. Please arrive dressed in full silks; girls should have hair pulled back and away from their face. Schedule is as follows:

10:20am	Little Dragons (will stay only 35 minutes)
10:45am	Youth: All Kids, BBC, All Black Belt Candidates (Candidates stay until 2pm)
12:40pm	All Teen/Adult

TICKETS: Please safeguard your tickets - NO REPLACEMENTS/REFUNDS FOR LOST/DAMAGED TICKETS

Tickets are \$18/each in advance or \$22/each at the door the day of the show. We highly recommend picking up your tickets now as they are available at the front desk. Performing students do not need a ticket but ***ALL Spectators 4 years and up must have a ticket for entry***, no exceptions. Our performance will begin promptly at 3:30pm so again - please get your tickets ahead of time to avoid delaying our show start time. ***We ask each student purchase 6 tickets per family and encourage you to invite your friends, neighbors, classmates, co-workers and your ENTIRE family!*** We only have one formal studio-wide event each year to provide the opportunity for students to demonstrate and engage their performance and presentation skills through this beautiful performing art and showcase their talent and progress! Theatre costs continue to increase and ticket sales help off-set a portion of the costs. Our students are so proud to show off their hard work so THANK YOU for your support!

PERFORMANCE DATE Saturday 11/4 at 3:30pm: NO MARTIAL ARTS CLASSES THIS DAY!

Some students may perform in more than one act, however when students have completed their final act they will be escorted out backstage and will exit around the side of the theatre where ***a parent should meet them outside at the theatre entrance to take them back to their seat.*** Please be mindful of others and do not stand and block aisle ways; no flash photography for the safety of our students. A videographer will be recording the show and an order form will be available at the show.

IMPORTANT PERFORMANCE TIMES & NOTES

Show starts promptly at 3:30pm however ALL PERFORMERS MUST BE PRESENT IN THE DESIGNATED STAGING AREA OUTSIDE ALONG THE SIDE OF THE THEATRE READY AND DRESSED NO LATER THAN 2:45pm (this means bring any weapons or gear which will be used in the show, hair pulled back away from the face for girls and clean silks with belts!). Please take bathroom breaks prior to lining up, allow yourself ample time for parking (\$3 permit available in lots) and any other family logistics you may anticipate! Parents, please drop off your children and **DO NOT STAY OR LINGER** with them or in the adjacent area as it is distracting for the kids and makes it difficult for us to organize students for proper staging. Thank you, we can't wait to showcase the students!
